KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

January 24 – February 3, 2011

Any child who resides in the district and will be five years old on or before December 2, 2011, is eligible for admission. You must verify your child's date of birth in the form of a certificate of birth, a baptismal certificate duly attested, a passport or an affidavit signed by the parent, guardian or custodian of the child.

The neighborhood school to which a student is assigned is determined by the permanent address. Students must be residing in the district at the time of registration. All students must provide two forms of proof of residence. One form of verification must be in the form of a current Pacific Gas and Electric bill or a 30-day conditional registration will be given with a current rental/lease/Escrow document. One additional form of verification is required. This may be in the form of a California driver's license, bank statement, pre-printed check, car insurance, etc. Photocopies will not be accepted. If you do not have the above residency documentation, please contact the Student Assignment Office, (408) 252-3000, extension 110.

State law mandates that all students be fully immunized before attending school. Immunization records, indicating all immunizations your child has received to date, must be provided in order to register. Although immunizations may not be complete at this time, immunization requirements must be met and proof provided to the school prior to the first day of school. If immunization requirements are not met, the child's name will be placed at the bottom of the registration list, which may affect your child's enrollment to the school. Immunization Requirements on the District website has a complete list of immunizations required.

You will be required to complete a health form and ask your physician to complete a second form verifying a physical examination before returning it to your school.

If you are interested in having your child attend another school in the district, you must register your child at your neighborhood school. After receiving a kindergarten registration receipt, you may request open enrollment or an alternative program at a school outside your attendance area during the open enrollment period February 11 – February 17, 2011. Additional information regarding your child's educational options and open enrollment procedures are available in the school office, on the district website or by contacting the Student Assignment Office, 252-3000, extension 110.

Completion of the registration material does not ensure your child's placement in next year's neighborhood school kindergarten class. Children will be enrolled on the opening day of school according to the order of registration. If registration should exceed available space in your neighborhood school, arrangements will be made to have your child attend another school within the district.

STUDENTS MUST BE IN ATTENDANCE ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN THEIR REGISTRATION NUMBER. STUDENTS NOT IN ATTENDANCE ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL WILL BE PLACED ON THE BOTTOM OF THE REGISTRATION LIST AND ASSIGNED A CLASSROOM ON A SPACE AVAILABLE BASIS.
