Things to remember to do before the end of the year:

- **Return all library books and school textbooks.** If your child cannot find any missing book, s/he will be charged. Books are very expensive and we cannot afford to absorb the cost of lost or damaged books. If the book is found after you have paid, your money will be refunded. If students have outstanding items on the last day of school for which they have not paid, parents will need to come to the office to pick up their child's report card and pay for the missing or damaged book. (AR5125.2, Education codes 48904 and 48904.3 states that schools can withhold report cards until books are returned of paid for).
- **Make arrangements for child(ren)** to be picked up promptly at the early dismissal time at 11:50 pm.
- **Check the Lost and Found for any lost items.** Any remaining items will be donated to a charity.
- **Notify the office if you will not be returning** next year or will be starting late. Students return on August 18, 2011.
- **If your child has medication in the school office, please pick it up on the last day of school, Tuesday, June 7th, between 8:15 am and 11:50 am.** Any medication that remains after the close of school will be discarded.

Parent School Survey Results are in: Thank you to everyone who took the parent survey this year. 74% of parents responded. Survey results were shared with the School Site Council in May. Below are a few of the results of our survey:

- 97% of parent are satisfied or very satisfied with Meyerholz School.
- 93% of parents feel that children are treated with respect at this school.
- 92% of parents indicate that the Language Arts program (reading, writing, etc.) is appropriate and challenging.
- 90% of parents indicate that the Math program is appropriate and challenging.

This data is important to the School Site Council (SSC) as they make program decisions for the next year. In the fall, School Site Council will review this data and all comments in detail as a reflections of our strengths and needs in guiding program decisions. During the upcoming year, we will make an effort to address concerns and questions. Parent input regarding district decisions will be forwarded to the appropriate District representatives.

NURSE'S NOTES: Medications in the Health Office Janice Leier, RN, MS, CNS... In order for either prescription or over-the-counter medications to be given at school, both the doctor and the parent must sign the form. When completed, bring the **Medication Administration** form and the medication (in the original container) to the secretaries in the school office.

IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Summer Registration
Registration will continue at the home school sites through June 17, 2011. After this date, registration will be shifted to the Cupertino Union School District Office, Student Assignment Department from June 20 through August 12, 2011. The District Office is located at 10301 Vista Drive in Cupertino, and will be open for registration from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Due to increased enrollment across the District, space is not guaranteed at home school. The District does guarantee a space at an overflow school within the District.

Change of Residence
Please be aware that parents/guardians are required to notify the school site or the District Office of a change in residency within 10 days of moving. Parents/guardians may complete a Request for Transfer form at the time the change of residence is submitted if they wish to remain at the current school site. Approvals are based on adequate space availability and there are no guarantees that a student may continue at the current school site. All other Request for Transfer forms will be available on August 10, 2011 at the school of choice.

Important Attendance Policy reminder
Students who leave early before the last day of school will be placed on the registration priority list after any students registering in the spring. If the number of neighborhood students exceeds capacity at the school site, students will be designated to an overflow school site until space becomes available at the home school.
