## Before Walk-A-Thon:

- ❑ Make Classroom Flag: A simple flag is made to represent each classroom to be proudly displayed and walked around the track at **Walk-A-Thon**.
- ❑ Set-Up: Help is needed both Friday afternoon into early evening and early Saturday morning (6:30 AM or 7:00 AM) to get all areas set-up for **Walk-A-Thon**.
- ❑ Basket Prep: Help arrange and wrap grade-level theme baskets for the drawing.
- ❑ Odd Jobs: Help as needed with laminating at District Office or with at home prep.
- ❑ Bake Sale Prep: Help set-up and display baked goods.



## During Walk-A-Thon:

- ❑ Announcer/M-C: Help generate school spirit around the track!
- ❑ Bake Sale: Sell baked goods.
- ❑ Clean-Up: Help clean up all areas for an hour after event.
- ❑ Face Painting: Help decorate the walkers and guests.
- ❑ First Aid: Deal with minor medical problems.
- ❑ Food (pick-up): Help pick up food supplies.
- ❑ Food Servers: Serve and/or prepare delicious foods.
- ❑ Food Ticket Sales: Sell tickets.
- ❑ Mascot: Wear the furry Wiley the Wildcat suit for a segment of the event.
- ❑ Punchers: Punch walkers' lap cards.
- ❑ Recycling: Help sort and package materials appropriate for recycling.
- ❑ Refreshments: Serve and/or prepare refreshments (sno-cones, sodas, etc.).
- ❑ Check In / Check Out: Check walkers in and out at the registration table.
- ❑ Mileage awards: Hand out mileage recognition bands to walkers.
- ❑ T-Shirts: Hand out student T-shirts and sell T-shirts.
- ❑ Water/Spotters: Supervise course and spray water on walkers.
- ❑ Pretzel/Water Station: Dispense water and pretzels to walkers.
